

Notice Inviting Expression of Interests (Eols) for Empanelment of Suppliers for the supply of Handloom Parts to the handloom weavers in Varanasi Mega Handloom Cluster under Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS)

Last date of receipt of EOI: 21 days from the date of the advertisement. In case the 21st day falls on a holiday, the next working day will be considered as the last day.

1. Background

The handloom sector is the second largest employer in India. This sector is unorganized and dispersed. There is absence of market intelligence, poor exposure to new technologies, product diversification, stiff competition with mechanized sector, inadequate infrastructure & common facilities, lack of adequate working capital etc. Large handloom clusters, like Varanasi, require massive investment for its integrated and holistic development. With this background, under Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development scheme (CHCDS), the Office of the Development Commissioner (Handlooms) is taking up up-gradation of handlooms with a view to enhance weavers' output / productivity and quality of the products, leading to an increase in the income of the weavers.

For up-gradation of existing working handlooms, Government of India will provide financial assistance to the extent of 80% for specified loom part/s and remaining 20% will be borne by the weavers. Accordingly, it has been decided to invite technical and financial bids on the basis of scope of work and eligibility criteria.

2. Empanelment of Suppliers

For the purpose of supplies of pre-identified loom parts (Annexure 2), Expressions of Interests (Eols) are invited from interested agencies associated with manufacturing of handlooms, preferably based in/around the district of Varanasi.

3. Scope of Work

- a) To supply quality handloom parts to applicants as per the specifications mentioned in the supply order. The parts will be collected by the weaver from the supplier's premises.
- b) To offer any other support as desired by the Office of DC (Handlooms) for successful implementation of the scheme.
- c) As per the technical survey conducted in the Varanasi cluster, the estimated number of defective loom parts is mentioned in the Annexure 3. However, the actual number of parts being replaced under the scheme will depend on the willingness of the weavers to contribute 20% of the cost for replacement of

their loom parts. Therefore, at present, actual number of weavers and the actual number of parts to be supplied are not known and will be known after the applications are received from the weavers along with their financial contribution.

3. Methodology of Supply of Handloom Parts

The Empanelled Suppliers (ES) will supply the pre identified loom parts based on the supply order placed by the Implementing Agency (IA) /i.e. Weavers' Service Centre (WSC), Varanasi to the identified beneficiaries in the Varanasi Mega Handloom Cluster.

Step 1: Based on the empanelment of the supplier/s of each part, the orders will be placed by the IA/office of the DC (Handlooms) to the supplier, considering the proximity of the supplier to the beneficiary or any methodology finalized by the office of the DC (Handlooms).

Step 2: Supply order will be prepared in triplicate. One copy of the order will be given to the beneficiary, second copy will be given to the supplier and third copy will be retained by the WSC, Varanasi.

Step 3: The supply order will indicate the name of the beneficiary, part/s to be replaced and the quantity of each part.

Step 4: A supplier, if required may coordinate and confirm the supply order with the WSC, Varanasi.

Step 5: Once the supply order is placed, the beneficiary will approach the supplier of the parts and will get the supply as per the quantity and specifications given in the supply order. The supplier will retain the copy of the supply order given to the weaver and obtain a receipt of the parts from the beneficiary and issue a copy of same to beneficiary .

Step 6: The above procedure for supply of parts to the beneficiaries will continue and immediately after supply of parts, verification will be done **within 10 days from the date of supply of parts to** beneficiary. An intimation of supply of the part/s to the beneficiary/ies by the supplier will be made every day to the WSC, Varanasi (Handlooms) by sending a copy of the receipt of parts by the beneficiary/ies.

Step 7: Once the verification is over and it is ascertained that the parts have been received/installed by the beneficiary, WSC, Varanasi will release the payment, including beneficiary and Gol share to the supplier.

Handloom Parts Specifications

- The loom parts supplied should be of highest quality and comply with the parts specifications and quality norms as attached in Annexure 2. A sample part is required to be submitted as per specifications and same has to be approved by the WSC, Varanasi.
- Supplier needs to stamp/emboss/engrave all loom parts supplied by him with a unique code {as decided by O/o DC (Handlooms)} for identification. Quality of the loom parts will be checked by the weaver at the time of taking delivery of the parts and has to fulfill the weaver's satisfaction.
- Any deviations found from approved quality of the loom parts during the course of implementation will result in debarring of the supplier from empanelment along with suitable penalty as decided by IA/Office of DC (Handlooms).
- All parts should carry a warranty of one year against any manufacturing defects from date of supply.

4. Eligibility Criteria for submission of Eol

- a) The Supplying Agency should be a registered entity with the sales tax department of the State Government.
- b) The Supplying Agency should have minimum two years experience of manufacturing handloom parts etc.

5. Procedure for Submission and Evaluation of Expression of Interest (Eol)

The proposal shall be submitted in TWO BID FORM viz .Technical Bid and Financial Bid. One Sealed envelope clearly marked "**Technical Bid for Empanelment of Suppliers for supply of Handloom parts in Varanasi Mega Handloom Cluster**", should contain the technical bid i.e two hard copies of the attached form (**Annexure – 1**) along with supporting documents, including Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of demand draft of Rs.10000/-(Rupees Ten thousand) in favor of Officer In-charge, WSC, Varanasi. The other sealed envelope should be clearly marked "**Financial Bid for Empanelment of suppliers for supply of Handloom parts in Varanasi Mega Handloom Cluster.**" should contain financial bid i.e. attached form (**Annexure 4**). Both these sealed envelopes should be put together in a bigger envelope duly sealed and submitted to : Officer In-charge, Weavers' Service Centre, Chowkaghat, Varanasi 221 002. Tel. No.: 2203834, 2207685. The applications should reach within 21 days from date of publication of advertisement. **A pre-bid conference will be held on 2.12.2011 (Friday) 1500 hrs.(3:00 P.M) in WSC, Varanasi Campus** at above mentioned address.

6. Process of project approval

- a) Applications for empanelment will be opened and assessed by a committee constituted by the O/o DC (Handlooms).

- b) Physical verification of the bidders, qualifying technical criterion will be done by a team, as decided by Office of the DC(Handlooms) to verify bidders capacities as declared in the EoI.
- c) Financial bid will be opened only, for the eligible agencies. Empanelment of suppliers will take place on basis of lowest bid for each part.
- d) The committee reserves the right to recommend amendments in the proposed project. The selection in that case will be subject to incorporation of those amendments.
- e) Decision of the committee shall be final and binding on all the applicants.
- f) Committee reserves the right to appoint more than one supplier for each part subject to eligibility, compliance to quality, price terms etc. In case, supply order is placed to two suppliers, the same will be split in the ratio of 60:40 i.e. minimum 60% to L-1 and maximum 40% to L-2 at L-1 rate and in case, the supply order is placed to three suppliers, the same may be split in the ratio of 50:30:20 i.e. minimum 50% to L-1, maximum 30% & 20% to L-2 at L-3 respectively at L-1 rate.

7. Payment terms and conditions:

Payments terms will be as follows:

- a. No advance payment will be made
- b. Payments will be made in installments, subject to submission of quality handloom parts as per the specifications to the beneficiaries and on verification of supplied parts.

8. Other terms and conditions:

- a. In financial bid, prices quoted need to be inclusive of taxes, duties etc.
- b. The prices quoted should be valid for minimum one year .
- c. Periodical updates to the WSC, Varanasi regarding the progress of the supplies.
- d. Confidentiality of the data provided by the office of the Development Commissioner (Handlooms) should be maintained.

9. Rights of Ministry of Textiles

The Ministry of Textiles reserves the right to accept/reject the proposals received without assigning any reasons whatsoever or may call for any additional information / clarification, if so required.

10. Agreement Cancellation

In the event of supplier willfully not commencing the supply within 30 working days after awarding the contract, Office of the Development Commissioner (Handlooms) at its sole discretion shall cancel this agreement in writing and forfeit the earnest money along with suitable penalty.

11. Court Jurisdiction

This shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Delhi/New Delhi.

12. Force Majeure Clause

Should any Force Majeure circumstances arise, each of the contracting party shall be excused for the non-fulfilling or for the delayed fulfillment of any of its contractual obligations, if the affected party within 15 days of its concurrence inform the other party in writing.

Force majeure shall mean fire, flood, natural calamities or any other acts as war, turmoil strikes (as not limited to the establishment of the seller), sabotage, explosion and quarantine restrictions beyond the control of either party.

13. Performance Security

The Empanelled Supplier will be required to deposit Performance Security for an amount of 5% of the value of the order in the form of Demand Draft.

The Office of the Development Commissioner (Handlooms), has introduced Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme for integrated & holistic development of Varanasi Handloom Mega Cluster (covering entire Varanasi District). As per the diagnostic study and Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the Varanasi Cluster, Upgradation of Handlooms is to be taken up, where the specified handloom parts, which are defective in the working handloom of the weavers will be replaced across the Cluster. For replacement of the parts, Government of India's contribution will not exceed 80% of the total cost of the handloom part/s and balance 20% will be contributed by the weaver. The specified handloom parts will be sourced from the Empanelled Suppliers.

Expressions of Interests (EOIs) are invited from eligible organizations for the empanelment of suppliers. The Eol should be submitted within 21 days from the date of the advertisement. In case, the 21st day is a holiday, the next working day will be considered as the last day. The bid should reach Officer In-charge, Weavers Service Centre, Varanasi by 15.00 hours of last day of submission of Eol.
