Tusar fabric of Chhattisgarh, called "kosa" is known all over the world for its special structure and design. The major product of the cluster includes Temple design saree , which is developed by the use of 3 shuttles. The yarn used for the production includes tasar in warp and gichha and dupion silk in weft. Saree has a great demand in the domestic market apart from this home furnishings also add to the product profile.
