Kashmir is known for its handloom and handicraft industry which occupies an important place in the economy of the state. The sector beside making significant contribution to its domestic and foreign exchange earning also provides employment to a large number of artisans. Among the main crafts, kani occupies an important place. The kani shawl has a very rich heritage and continues to be a significant craft in the state of Jammu and Kashmir. Apart from this a major chunk of artisans are involved in making woollen products like blanket, raffal and pashmina shawl.
